1. This is an application seeking extension of interim bail for a further period of two months granted to the applicant vide order dated 05.09.2022.

2. Mr Aggarwal, learned counsel for the applicant has drawn my attention to the medical documents of the applicant which show that the applicant is suffering from continued state of Herpes and he is admitted in the hospital. Mr Aggarwal further states that Herpes is a contagious disease.

5. In case the medical documents are found to be forged, fabricated or incorrect, the respondent is at liberty to file an application seeking cancellation/modification of the order passed today.

6. The application is disposed of accordingly.
